# A catch in Citronelle

## *Community club scores big in its first bass tournament*

The Citronelle Community Fishing Club just formed in 2018, but it quickly established itself in a major way during its first tournament by sweeping both divisions in the Alabama Bass Federation Junior Angler and High School Trail.

During the event held out of Steele Creek near Satsuma in September 2018, Tyler Malone and Sawyer Simison, two sophomores at Citronelle High School, won the High School Division. Not to be outdone, Huntley Dees and Triton Graham won the Junior Division.

“We are very proud of these kids,” exclaimed Jeffrey L. Pippin, coach of the Citronelle Community Fishing Club. “Our team is not the high school team because we have some club members who

are from middle school and some home-schooled kids who live in the area who have an opportunity to fish with our program. We started this club in 2018 to give more students opportunities to compete and possibly earn college scholarships in the future.”

Student anglers from sixth grade and up, ages 11 through 18, can compete in events. Twelve student anglers in the club fish at the high school level and 12 fish in the Junior Division with two anglers per boat fishing in each tournament.

“Right now, we don’t have any females on the team, but we would like to attract some females to fish with us,” said Pippin who is also one of the assistant football
