Cornhole Official Tournament Rules

Each round includes 2 players on opposite teams. 4 bags tossed per player per end, alternating shots with the team last to score points going first. (Odd/Even to determine who gets to make the choice.) Next round switches to the other end.

1. Bag In-The-Hole - 3 points.
2. Bag on the Board - 1 point.
3. No "leaners" or Bag over the hole scoring. It's either in the hole for 3 points or 1 point for being on the board and not in the hole.
4. Team with the most points in the round scores the difference in round points, also referred to as cancellation scoring. For example, if at the end of the round Team A has 9 points and Team B has 6 points, the result of the round will be Team A scoring 3 points.
5. First team to 21 wins, must win by 2. Winning team advances to next round, losing team is eliminated.
6. We reserve the right to adjust points required to win prior to a tournament round to accommodate for time available.



Ice Cream Eating Contest and Rules

Contestants must be at least 18 years of age. The contest will last 6 minutes. The first person to finish 1 quart of vanilla ice cream wins. If no one finishes their ice cream in allotted time, the person who has eaten the most will win. The Judges' decision will be final.

Ribbons will be given to 1st and 2nd place.

Contestants are seated with hands resting flat on table.

When official Judge says go, the time begins and contestants may begin enjoying their ice cream. Contestants may use spoons or the licking method to eat ice cream. Container must be completely empty. No solid ice cream left. Judges' decisions are final. Spoons will be provided. Contestants will only use the utensils provided. Cups of water and napkins will be provided for all contestants. At the approach of the 6 minute mark, the Judge will begin a count-down. When "STOP" is called all contestants must stop. A spoonful of ice cream in contestants' mouth may be eaten. Spoons of ice cream on the way to contestant's mouth must be put down. The winner will be contestant that finishes quart or eats the most out of quart.

The Judges' decision is final.


FRUIT PIE BAKING CONTEST
