Established in 1950, PCMH is a nonprofit, county-owned critical access hospital. PCMH is a 25 bed acute care facility with a surgery center, birthing center, full outpatient services and Emergency department. PCMH is a member of the American Hospital Association, Indiana Hospital Association and National Rural Health Association and is licensed by the state of Indiana and accredited by the Healthcare Facilities Accreditation Program.

PCMH moved to its new facility in May of 2015 in order to improve patient flow, access to healthcare and to better expand upon the services offered. In 2018, PMCH began a hospitalist program designed to ensure that patients have availability to a physician 24 hours a day and allowed the community primary care physicians to have more time in their practices.

PCMH is committed to providing quality healthcare and exemplary customer service in the most caring, compassionate, and effective manner. We are dedicated to improving the health and quality of life for the communities we serve while reducing

the burden of illness, injury, and disability.

PCMH's mission is supported by the hospital Foundation and their continuous support to raise funds.
