National Lime & Stone produces a wide variety of construction-grade products for Ohio's infrastructure and a number of basic industries. Crushed stone, in one form or another, is found in most construction projects. National's Carey Aggregate operation is a major supplier of very high quality dolomitic limestone for local construction needs and for eastern Ohio, West Virginia and Pennsylvania market areas. National currently operates multiple distribution yards in eastern Ohio with new growth opportuni-

ties always being considered. The Carey plant has the ability to ship material on two different rail lines to eastern Ohio and into other regions that do not have these quality deposits available. In addition to producing construction-grade products, National's Carey plant is reported to have some of the best agricultural lime in the state.

The Carey Minerals plant produces significant quantities of specialty dolomite minerals for the glass industry; it continues to be the largest supplier of dried dolomitic limestone to the glass industry in the country.

This dried dolomite is used as a raw material in the manufacturing processes that produce windshield glass, plate glass windows and light bulbs. Other manufacturing processes which use this dried dolomitic stone include the steel, automotive, roofing and agricultural industries. National's Pellet Plant produces a specialty

fertilizer product for the professional lawn care industry.

Driven by a century-old tradition of customer service, National Lime & Stone operates highly automated and efficient production facilities and is unrelenting in its continued efforts to reduce costs and offer the highest level of customer service. National is a long-time steward of its non-renewable natural resources and has well-defined programs to preserve the land and the environment during all stages of commercial production and thereafter.
