The orthopedic specialists that choose Wyandot Memorial bring extensive knowledge and expertise to care for patients of all ages.

Cornel Van Gorp, M.D., is fellowship trained in hip and knee joint replacement and has more than 20 years of experience behind him. He uses proven technology and techniques for joint replacement and reconstruction and offers same-day hip and knee joint surgery for medically-qualified patients. He has been a key advocate for Wyandot Memorial's Swing Bed program, so he can keep close tabs on patients as they recuperate and transition to home.

Dr. Van Gorp recruited one of his neighbors, Joseph Milet, M.D., to give the folks at Wyandot a top-notch specialist for shoulder surgery, including

rotator cuff repairs, labral repairs and shoulder replacement. Dr. Milet received fellowship training in reconstruction and replacement of the shoulder and elbow from the Mayo Clinic and is considered an expert in his field by his peers.

Another fellowship-trained surgeon on staff at WMH is Ryan Klinefelter, M.D., who specializes in complex hand and wrist injuries. Patients report positive outcomes from ganglion cyst removal, open reduction and internal fixation of hand and wrist fractures, dorsal compartment release of fingers, trigger finger release and other surgeries.

Hossein Elgafy, M.D., completed fellowships in both orthopedic and general surgery and performs general orthopedic surgery, as well as minimal-

ly-invasive procedures and neck and back surgery, including revision.

The newest addition to Wyandot's orthopedics team is Nevada native Diane Von Stein, M.D. She was the first female to complete an orthopedic residency at the University of Cincinnati and brings more than 30 years of experience to her hometown hospital. Dr. Von Stein provides non-operative orthopedic care for children and adults and works closely with primary care providers, other orthopedic specialists and hospital departments caring for bone-related injuries.

Physician Assistant Bob Kiffmeyer has focused on orthopedic care for 13+ years and collaborates with doctors Van Gorp, Milet and Von Stein.

The orthopedic team at WMH is just one example of the

skilled and compassionate physicians and surgeons, nurse practitioners, nurse midwives, physician assistants and audiologist available at the hospital. The medical providers, emergency department, UrgentCare, medical/ surgical unit and intensive care all benefit from the services of the on-site laboratory, pharmacy, respiratory therapy, x-ray/imaging and cardiology departments. Physical, occupational and speech therapies are offered in the therapy gym, which is also home to the Wellness Center's cardiac and pulmonary rehab, disease prevention programs and health screenings. Special services include CancerCare, Hematology and Infusion; MRI and PET/CT; WoundCare Healing Center; JobCare occupational health; EEG; sleep studies and patient navigation.

Wyandot Senior Village, Inc., is an independent living community located in Upper Sandusky.

Independent living can involve home ownership in a retirement community or senior apartment rentals for individuals who can still live independently. These communities provide for a safe, low-maintenance lifestyle, allowing residents to focus on socializing and engaging in recreational activities.

Housing.

Wyandot Senior Village offers low-income apartments for persons 62 years of age or older or who are handicapped/disabled regardless of age. Rental assistance may be available.

The independent living community consists of 50 units. All

are one-floor plan designs with front and back doors. The units also have a patio, carpeted living room and bedrooms and are furnished with a stove and refrigerator. An emergency call system is located in the bathroom and bedroom. Water and trash pickup are furnished. All apartments are cable TV ready, which is paid with your rent.

Pets are permitted with some requirements and a deposit.

Rental assistance may be available.

Commons area.

The manager's office is located in the commons area.

A large community room is available for family gatherings, potlucks, meetings, etc.

The laundry room, which has three washers and three dryers, is located by the office. One

dryer and one washer are accessible for anyone who may be disabled.

up at the office of the manager in the commons area.

Office hours are Monday-Thursday, 7 a.m.-3 p.m. and Friday, 7 a.m.-noon.
