In 2011, FACTS and Christy Insurance acquired Peiffer Accounting and Tax Service to extend their products to Carey and the surrounding Wyandot County community.

FACTS is a complete tax return service which includes returns for: Individual 1040 (federal, state, school district, city), Schedule F for Farmers, Schedule C for small businesses, partnerships, corporation for extended businesses, limited liability companies, trusts and estates. In addition, FACTS offers payroll services, in-house bookkeeping and on-farm computer accounting software to assist with all record needs.

Christy Insurance is a full-line agency offering home, auto, commercial, life, health supplements, farm, Federal Crop and Federal Flood Insurance.

The First Citizens National Bank

As a part of Carey since 1992, and of Wyandot County for 159 years, The First Citizens National Bank has remained committed to serving the needs of its customers and its community. Locally owned and managed, The First Citizens National Bank continues its long tradition of service to its customers and to its communities. The main office in Upper Sandusky, along with the banking offices in Carey, Dunkirk, Marion, Nevada and Powell, provide the largest, most convenient branch network in the area. The bank's

roots in Wyandot County are deep, reaching back to 1860 and the Exchange Bank, whose assets and liabilities were used by a group of individuals from the Upper Sandusky-Harpster area to establish the First National Bank in 1863.

In 1946, The First National Bank and the Citizens Savings Bank merged to form The First Citizens National Bank, which took up residence in the Citizens Savings Bank building on the northwest corner of Wyandot and Sandusky avenues in Upper Sandusky – the

location of the bank's Main Office.

In the years since the consolidation, the bank acquired three other banks in Wyandot County: The Nevada Deposit Bank (1953), the Village Bank in Wharton (1991), and the Carey office of Diamond Savings (1992). And a drive-through location was opened in Upper Sandusky on Wyandot Avenue in 1963. The First Citizens National Bank expanded outside Wyandot County, building banking centers in Powell and in Marion in 2000 and 2002 and extensively renovated the home office in 2003. A second Marion location opened in February 2018. The bank continues to seek new ways to serve customers by identifying and meeting financial needs.

The Carey Banking Center underwent an expansion and renovation project in 2017 that increased the office size by over 40%. Improvements to the exterior of the building included reconfiguring of the two-lane drive-through as well as the front facade

that features limestone trim details to tie in with Carey's history of stone quarrying. The interior of the building was updated with the latest in technology and state-of-the-art furnishings.

Among new products offered in the past few years include mobile banking, Zelle, mobile deposit, e-statements, health savings accounts, remote deposit capture, business and personal debit and credit cards and locally serviced merchant services.

Throughout the many changes over the years, serving customers
