Carey is a pelletized lime and pelletized gypsum manufacturing and distribution terminal and Mineral Processing is one of the largest manufacturers of those products in the United States, providing them in large bulk quantities or by the bag.

Mineral Processing began operations in late 1989 to early 1990. The Andersons Inc. purchased the firm in August 2008 but the company still goes by its original name. Nick Klein is operations manager and Susan Oliveto is customer service manager for the firm, which employs from 16 to 20 people.

Pelletized lime and pelletized gypsum are proven soil management tools for greater yields and profits. Pelletized lime provides quick acidity adjustment and elemental calcium and magnesium for producing top yields and profits in production agriculture. Pelletized gypsum is a pH-neutral source of soluble calcium and sulfur, well-known for use on potatoes and many other vegetable crops.

The Andersons is a diversified company with interests in the grain, ethanol and plant nutrient sectors of U.S. agriculture, as well as in rail-car leasing and repair, turf products production and general merchandise retailing. Founded in Maumee in 1947, The Andersons has operations across the United States, in Puerto Rico, and has rail equipment leasing interests in Canada and Mexico.

Mineral Processing is part of the Plant Nutrient Group, one of five operating groups of The Andersons which has wholesale and retail facilities in Ohio, Michigan, Indiana, Illinois, Florida, Wisconsin,

Minnesota and Puerto Rico. These five facilities serve about 2 million tons of dry and liquid agricultural nutrients annually, through warehousing/distribution, formulation and custom application. The group also formulates low corrosive anti-icers, nitrogen reagents for air pollution control systems, water treatment for irrigation systems and dust abatement products.
