Kurtz's products are also sold at Koehler Drug in Upper Sandusky to better serve Rams Fans.

Kurtz Family Store has been selling Carey High School varsity jackets for over 25 years.

Boarding is also a feature offered at Lincoln Way Animal Hospital; the caring staff can give owners peace of mind knowing their animals are in good hands while they need to be away. Kennels feature a raised platform to provide a resting area.

A convenient pick-up window allows for medicine and food to be picked up without having to get out

of the vehicle. All facilities offer 24-hour animal care in the case of an after-hour emergency.
