- 5. All other poultry must show an official form to show a record of a negative test for pullorumtyphoid disease conducted within 90 days or an official form to show they originate from parent stock tested and found negative within 12 months.
- 6. No exhibitor may show more than two entries in each subdivision.
- Cock: a male bird hatched prior to 2019. Hen: a female bird hatched prior to 2019. Cockerel: a male hatched in 2019. Pullet: a female hatched in 20189.
