May 13. The financial report was read by Kim Fenske, County Treasurer and approved by the Court. The ending balances for April 30, 2019 were: Payroll \$0, General \$1,435,227.82,

Road \$506,293.10, Jail \$711,749.88, LGEA \$8476.41, ASAP \$98,591.43, Grants \$29,630.54, Tourism \$5,304.49, Dispatch \$127,078.82, Airport \$45,947.40,

Project \$25,037.98, DFC \$12,101.21, Airport Board \$48,557.55 and ABC \$43,477.50. The total of all funds was \$3,097,474.13.
