ports, 6 drug search warrants executed with 11 arrests.

The financial report was read by Kim Fenske, County Treasurer and approved by the Court. The ending balances for June 30, 2019 were: Payroll \$0, General \$1,704,457.58, Road \$363,172.50, Jail \$517,261.15, LGEA \$5,156.00, ASAP \$107,723.76, Grants \$25,665.06, Tourism \$11,976.45, Dispatch \$112,668.08, Airport \$51,214.43, Airport Project \$95,699.98, DFC \$12,101.21, Airport Board \$55,156.42, ABC \$44,018.65. The total of all funds was \$3,106,271.27.

The Fiscal Year to Date report July 1, 2018 - June 30, 2019 was also read by County Treasurer Kim Fenske. The Unencumbered Cash Balances were: Payroll \$0, General \$1,525,986.23, Road \$335, 870.67, Jail \$516,628.75, LGEA \$5,156, ASAP \$107,723.76, Grants \$25,665.06, Tourism \$11,976.45, Dispatch \$112,688.08, Airport \$51,105.67, Airport Project \$95,699.98, DFC \$12,101.21, Airport Board \$55,156.42, ABC \$43,379.05. The total of all funds was \$2,899,117.33.

Gray Tomblin II, the Commissioner of Rural Roads and Municipal Aid addressed the court on the county's discretionary fund. Tomblin relayed that Governor Bevin has approved \$313,539 for road reconstruction on the intersection of Hwy 910 and Hwy 76. Over the last twelve months that brings the total discretionary fund for the county to \$591,167.

A motion was made and approved to transfer \$25,000 from Gener-

al to Tourism, \$46,153 from General to 911 Dispatch, \$538,015 from General to Jail, \$8,118 from General to LGEA, \$10,000 from ABC to 911 Dispatch, and \$15,000 from General to Airport.

The LCADD Grant awaiting approval was motioned and accepted by the court.

A motion was made and carried to approve resolution 19-11; the designation of TVA funds to RCIDA.

A motion was made and approved for AE transfers for the 19-20 fiscal year.

One bid was submitted for the D Mann Road Slide Project by Hinkle Environmental Services LLC. The cost for the project would be approximately \$160,080. A motion was made and approved for the bid if FEMA would also approve.

Marty Kazsuk of the county's Fire Departments presented information for consideration concerning new

methods of collecting funds for the Fire Department's and their services.

The Affirmative Action report for the 18-19 Fiscal Year was presented by Treasurer Kim Fenske. 39 Hires, 13 females 26 Males, 24 part time employees hired, 7 female 17 male, 15 full time hires 6 female 9 males. A motion was made and passed to submit the report.

The ABC Report was for the month of May, Regulatory fees collected \$11,261.78; \$2,069.42 of that was paid to the city of Jamestown.

\$1,053.26 was transferred from General to Grants.

Ambulance Board Chairman Randy Marcum addressed the court on magistrates directing calls about concerns or information to the proper EMS authority to better the public presence of EMS to the community, to better inform the public, as well as maintaining transparency for any of their concerns.
