Green County Board of Education will have their annual public forum at the Board office Jan. 18 at 1 p.m. CST to assess the current Lo-

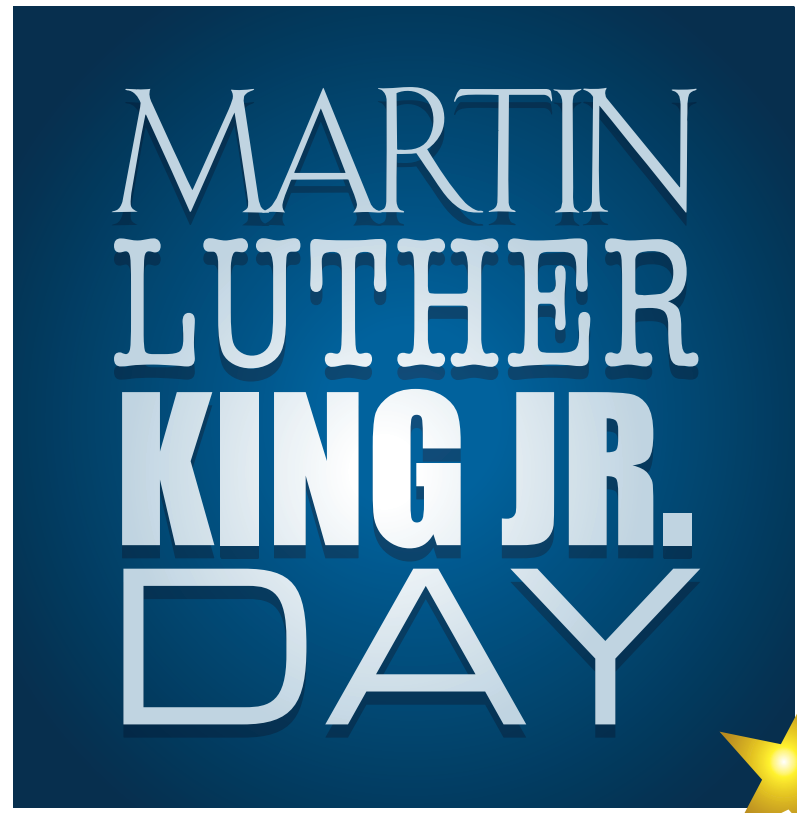
cal Wellness Policy.
