The primary school dance team was all smiles as they performed at the conclusion of the sixth grade game Thursday evening at Green County Middle School.



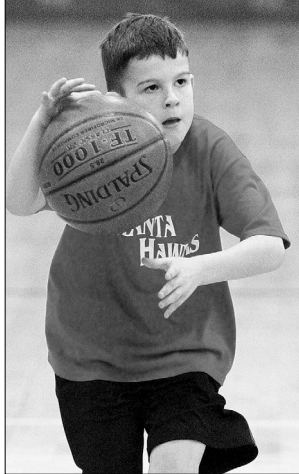

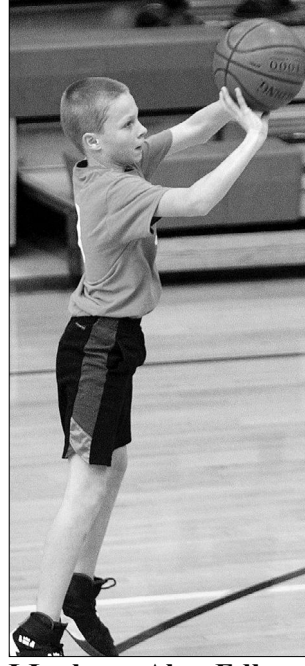
