(1) A request from Garry Elmore to add the road off of Hubert G. Wright Road into the county road system.

Concerning new business, magistrates approved:

(1) A salary increase for the deputy coroner, from \$250 per month to \$300 per month;

(2) An annual contract with D-C Elevator Company for quarterly periodic maintenance of elevators at the Green Co. Judicial Center;

(3) The allocating of \$20,000 to the Green Co. Park Board for program support in 2019;

(4) The acknowledgement of the Green County Clerk and Sheriff's audit for the year ending Dec. 31, 2017;

(5) The winning bids for the construction of the concession building at American Legion Park. They were: Steve Curry, plumbing; Sturdi Built, building; and Adam Boyd, electric; and,

(6) A block grant

request by the Green County Ambulance Service amounting to \$100,000.

"This is a "pass-through" grant that will flow through the fiscal court and will be passed on to the ambulance service to be used to upgrade their fleet," said Judge-Executive John Frank.

The county judge-executive also provided an update concerning Hardin Scientific.

He said, "The Green Co. Fiscal Court is currently awaiting approval of a \$1,000,000 Community Development Block Grant and the City of Greensburg is in the process of submitting a request to the Kentucky Economic Development Authority for approval of a grant in the approximate amount of \$600,000. These two grants combined, if awarded, will be used to complete the buildout of the existing spec building to be used by Hardin Scientific."
