A valiant effort was given by the Dragons Friday at home against the Hart County Raiders. The Bush Brothers scored a combined total 36 points, 18 each.

Sophomore Gunner Bush has enjoyed a final season playing with his brother.

"It's been exciting playing with my brother," said Bush. "I will continue to improve as a player and teammate."

Bush plans to work on his shot outside of the paint.

Hart County led 31-36 with 5.1 seconds remaining in the first half. In the final play of the half Dennis Rose caught the ball mid-court and dribbled in for a textbook lay-up. The lead was cut to 3.

The Raiders outside shooting edged the final score past the Drag-

ons who struggled from three-point range. The team free throws have stayed consistent, 22-27.

Two additional Dragons scored in double-digits, Dennis Rose and Hunter McCubbins scored 12 each, Zylar Bardin-9, Braeden Sluder-5, and Bryce Blakeman-4.

Brody was one rebound shy of a double-double. McCubbins stayed busy on the inside and grabbed 6 rebounds, Gunner Bush-5, Rose-2, Sluder-4, Jackson Johnson-2, and Blakeman-2.
