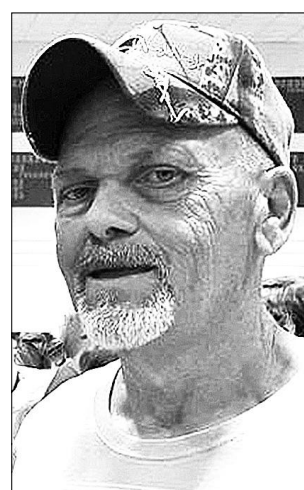
**Dwight London, 59**

The word "courage" comes from the Latin word "cor" meaning heart, via Old French, "corage," meaning heart or innermost feelings.
