Jessica Clark currently serves as president of the local high school FFA chapter. She has been an active member throughout high school and has many accomplishments to her credit.

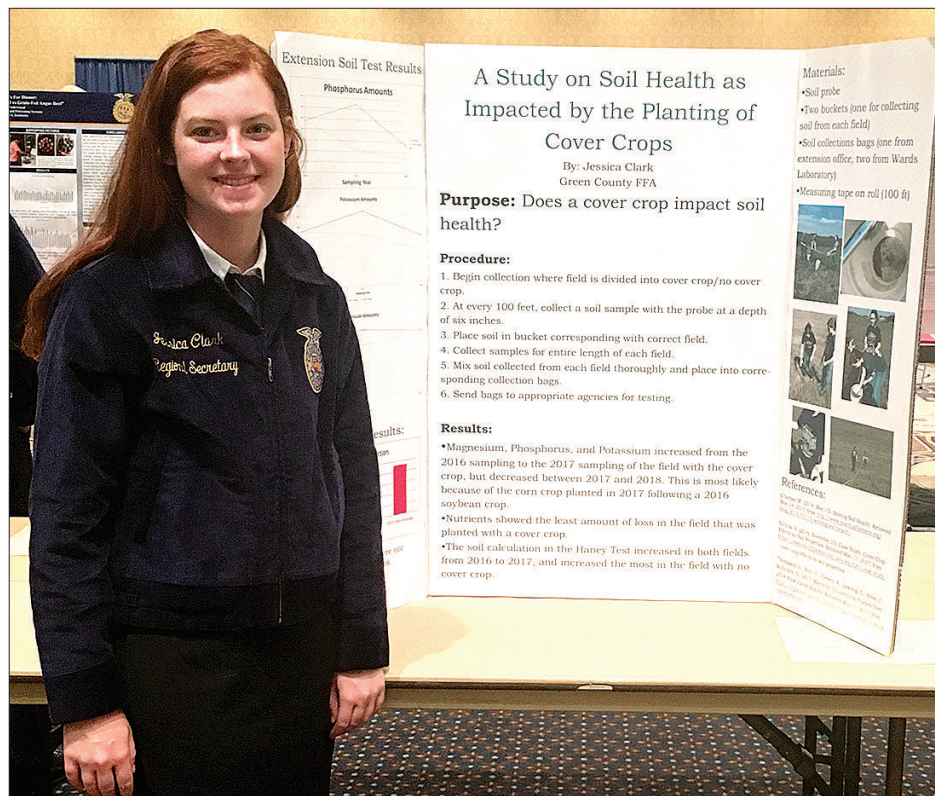
On her deciding to become a member of FFA, Clark said, "I joined FFA because it was an interest of mine, and it was something I wanted to go into as a career."
