

Dragons fall to Raiders in District first round

The Dragons' season ended February 20 after a heartbreaking 72-79 first-round, 18th District loss to the Hart County Raiders in Hart County.

The two teams tied early in the game with 9 points each, but the Raiders went on a 16-2 scoring run in the second quarter and built a 30-11 lead over the Dragons.

The Dragons returned to the court for the second half and outscored the Raiders, but fell just a

couple baskets shy of taking over the lead.

The five starters put up big numbers for their team, their grit pushed them to maximum capacity during the second half both on the offense and defense. Brody Bush led the Dragons in scoring, 17 points and 4 rebounds, Dennis Rose-15 points, 4 rebounds, Gunner Bush-13 points, 6 rebounds, Hunter McCubbins-10 points, 7 rebounds, Zylar Bardin-10 points, 3 rebounds, Braeden Sluder-5 points, Jackson Johnson-1 rebounds, and Bryce Blakeman-2 points, 2 rebounds.

Brothers Brody and Gunner Bush shared one last memory on the court; they were both named to the 18th District All-Season and All-Tournament teams. The duo led the team in scoring for the season, field goal percentage, and free throws.

Teammate Bardin was named Kentucky.com Boys' Basketball Player of the Week (February 10-16). Bardin scored 25 points, 6 for 10 from the three-point line in the Dragons 78-61 win over Washington County. He received a total of 9,026 votes.

Gunner Bush scored a total of 423 points during the season, he averaged 15.7 points per game, and shot a team high field goal percentage of 66.3%. Brody Bush scored a

Gunner also finished the season ranked 14th in the state in field goal percentage.

total of 258 points, 9.2 ppg, Bardin-239, 8.5 ppg, Rose-227, 8.1 ppg, Sluder-161, 5.8 ppg, McCubbins-159, 5.7 ppg, Bobby Landis-102, 6.4 ppg, Johnson-59, 2.2 ppg, Blakeman-59, 2.6 ppg, Kellen Whitlow-15, .9 ppg, Keaton Perkins-4, 1 ppg, Zach Ferguson-3, 1 ppg, and Casen Murray-1, 5 ppg.

Rose finished the season with a team high season free throw percentage of 72.6%, he hit 45 of 62.

Gunner Bush led the team with a season rebound total of 163, McCubbins-137, Brody Bush-117, Lan-

dis-53, Sluder-91, Bardin-74, Rose-61, Blakeman-42, Murray-2, Johnson-27, Perkins-4, Whitlow-8, Ferguson-1, and Issac Young-1.

The team finished the season with a record of 10 wins and 18 losses, a number of the losses were within 8 points of winning.

Brody Bush, Bardin, Rose, Landis, and McCubbins will transition into their final spring sports season before they graduate and move on to furthering their education in the vocational or traditional college setting.
