One must also have earned at least 21 merit badges, including 13 that are required.

the upcoming season.

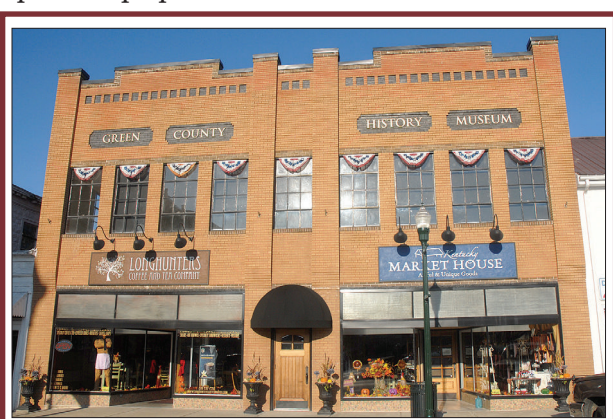
This is an opportunity to clear out unwanted cleats, ball pants, gloves, batting gloves, belts, tennis shoes, bat bags, and athletic clothing.
