The event will begin with a meet and greet featuring World Known Televi-

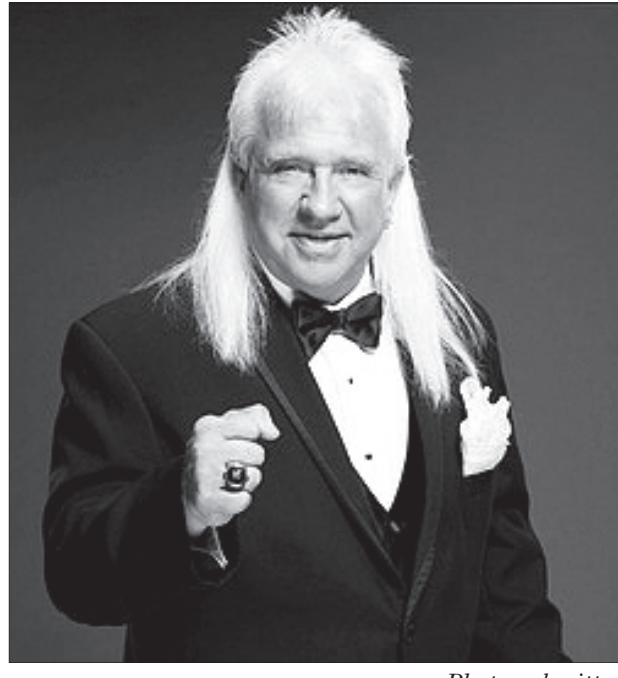
