

Fatality, three injuries in Taylor County wreck

A fatal accident occurred Thursday evening on Greensburg Road in Taylor County.

According to reports, Taylor County Sheriff's Department investigated a two-vehicle accident at approximately 8 p.m. ET March 7.

A 2013 Mazda, driven by Sharon Clark, 62, Campbellville, was traveling East

on Greensburg Road near the Davis Road intersection when her vehicle struck a deer.

According to the police report, the vehicle over-corrected and struck a 2016 Mitsubishi driven by Timothy Shirley, 51, of Summersville. Shirley's vehicle was traveling West.

Clark was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Shirley, along with two passengers Lisa

Shirley, 52, and a minor, were transported to Taylor Regional Hospital. Lisa Shirley was later flown to Vanderbilt Hospital with nonlife threatening injuries.

The Taylor County Sheriff's Department was assisted by personnel from the Campbellville-Taylor County EMS, Green County EMS and Campbellville-Taylor County Fire and Rescue.

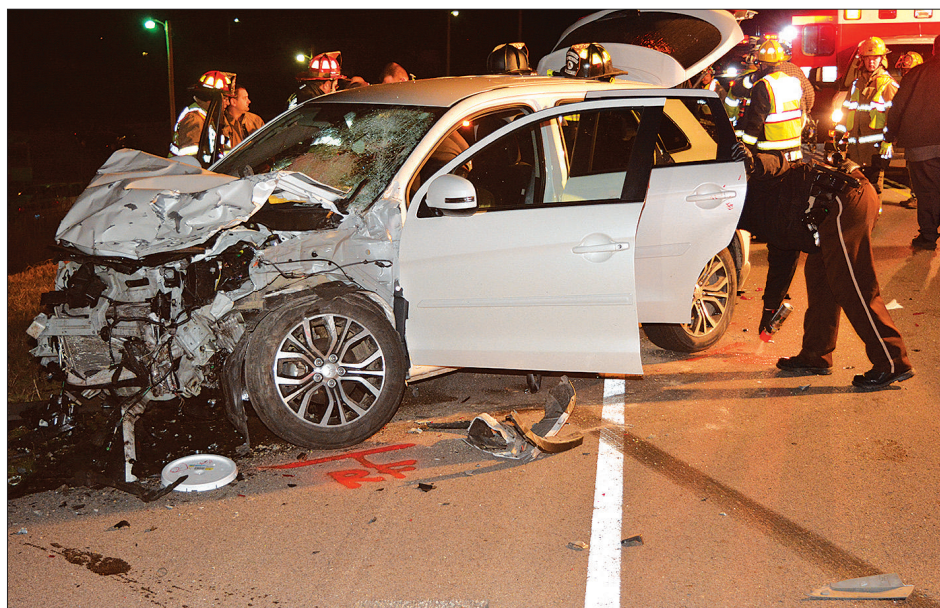
