

Live Fire Training held in Grab community



A live Kentucky State Fire Training exercise was held Saturday in the Grab community. Owner Patricia Pascoe gave permission for rescuers to use the two-story house for the training exercise which took approximately eight hours. Green County, Grab, Summersville, Exie, Adair, Casey, Campbellsville-Taylor, and Brush Creek were among the fire departments participating.



Over 40 participants were involved in the training held on Simpson Road. The exercise was coordinated by Josh Whiting, Jamestown. Instructors took in groups of three rescuers at a time and used the training to teach about smoke reactions, safety issues and more. Approximately 21 firefighters entered the burning structure.



Exie Fire Department set their pumper up to supply to attack lines and to protect exposure. Summersville Fire Department tankers supplied the Exie pumper. The exercise had many volunteers helping assist. Special thanks is offered to all departments, instructors, Grab Fire Dept. for food and Oak Grove for parking.


