Sadly, Beard suffered a leg injury last season, an injury that despite high accolades from her physical therapist, has forced her into early retirement.

"Failure will never overtake me if my determination to succeed is stronger," Beard said. "When I got hurt last year I became angry and wanted to give up, but when I began to realize others looked up to me, that made me stronger in myself and faith."

"You have to keep faith and believe in God's plan for you and keep your head up and even on your worst days believe that there is someone somewhere that has it even worse."

Sickness and injury has plagued the team early on, but they are not going to be discouraged.

Haley Judd was recently cleared to return to sports after

she suffered a ligament injury on her ankle during basketball season. The sophomore, who has started on varsity since her seventh grade year,

has faith in her team. "This year is definitely going to be tough- at first we have had every diversity already that a team could face," said Judd. "Even with the adversity, we're ready and we'll play together and work as hard not matter what."

The Lady Dragons took the field in their home opener Monday evening against Metcalfe County and yesterday evening they hosted Warren East.

March 21 they will host Marion County with first pitch being thrown at 5 p.m. CST.
