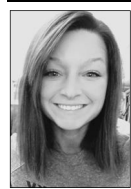


GCPS Spring Festival is this FRIDAY!

Friday, March 22: Taco/cheese or hot dog, lettuce, tomato,

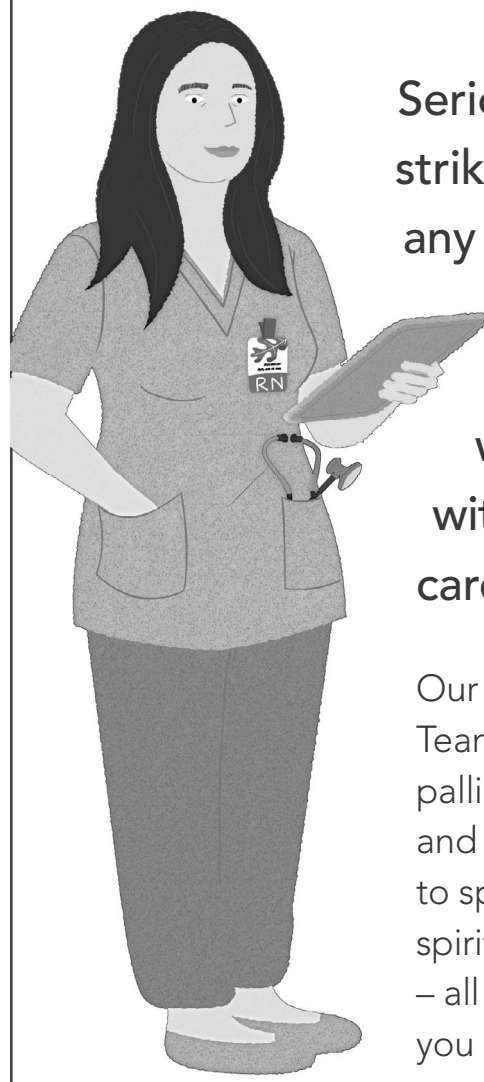
refried beans, mixed fruit, apple, chocolate chip cookie, milk.
