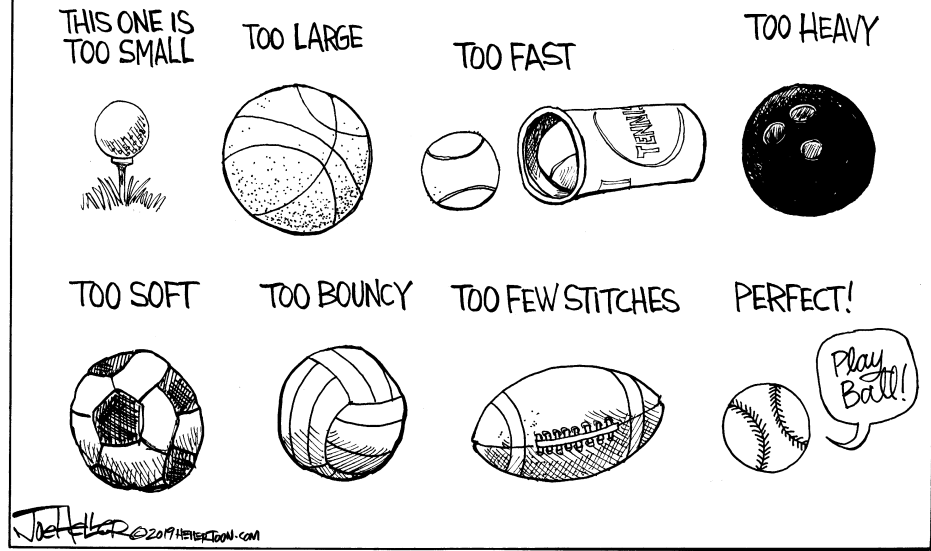
Garden program

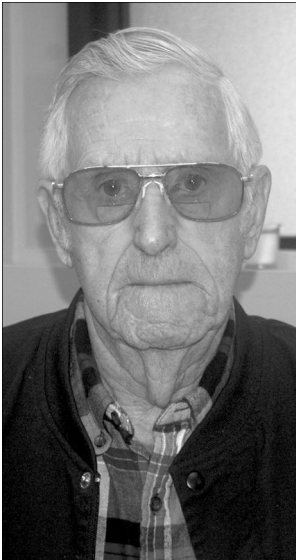
