

Waveland Mansion, on the Nicholasville Pike, is a Greek Revival Structure that was built in 1847 by Joseph Bryan. The Antebellum Plantation produced tobacco and hemp for its cash crops. Waveland became a Kentucky State Historic Site in 1971.
