## Lady Dragons win at LaRue

The Green County Varsity Lady Dragons Track and Field team traveled to Hodgenville April 16 and won the LaRue County All-Comers meet.

Six schools competed in the meet.

First place finishes for the girls were: Carlee Coffey in the 1600 meter run, with a time of 5:53.24; Emma Renfrow, 100 meter hurdles in 19.13; Cassie Lindsay in the triple jump, leaping 30-09.00, and Autumn Sidebottom in the javelin throw turbo jav, recording a distance of 67-06.

The team scored 137 points to runnerup LaRue County who had 107.

The Varsity Dragons placed first in five events, including Mason Stone in the 800 meter run with a time of 2:09.17; Nash Johnson, 300 meter hurdles in 47.75; Thaddeus Moon, shot put and javelin throw turbo jav with throws of 43-04.75 and 93-11, respectively.

The 4 x 800 meter relay team of Rylee Martin, Matthew Soto, Austin Purvis and Devon Mouser also came in first, running in 9:54.73. The team tallied
