## Dragons win first game of 5th Regional Tournament


Gunner Bush led the way for the Dragons with two home runs and five RBI's including a three run blast in the seventh inning to force extra innings.

a relief pitcher, shut down the Nelson County offense and the game advanced to extra innings. In the top of the ninth inning, with two

outs, Rose was hit by a pitch and Brody Bush reached first base on a fielder's choice, setting up his brother, Gunner to hit a three run homer, giving the Dragons a 6-3 lead.

The Cardinals threatened in the bottom of the ninth, scoring two runs and leaving one runner on base as the Dragons won

Sluder was credited with the win as he went 2 and two-thirds innings, giving up three hits and two runs. Brody Bush was the starting pitcher, giving up 4 hits and three runs. He was replaced by Casen Murray who pitched four and onethird scoreless innings before Sluder took over pitching duties.

Green County improved to 17-20 on the year with the win over Nelson. North Hardin, the semi-final opponent is 31-5.

Arps also has been a part of roadside trash pickup within the county.


Referring to his being recognized at the banquet, he said,
