

Seymour wins second at state in the 400M

Jullian Seymour finished runner-up in the 400 meter dash at the KTCCCA Middle School State Track and Field Championships May 25 at the University of Louisville, recording a time of 54.17.

Seymour also was eleventh in the 200 meter dash with a time of 25.21.

Kelson McKinney had two top 10 finishes.

He placed sixth in the shot put with a throw of 40-02.00 and ninth in the discus at 123-04.

Other results were: 4 x 800m relay - 18. Green County (Jayden Marr, Houston Hodges, Carter Smothers, and Blake Bryant) - 10:05.34;

Twenty-four hours later, the Lady Dragons returned to LaRue County for the 18th District Tournament championship game against the host team Lady Hawks.

Keltner returned to the mound for the final game. Another shut-out for the team as Keltner walked zero, allowed only three hits, and struck out 10 Lady Hawk batters.

An error free game proved the focus of the team.

Senior pitcher was very humbled and happy to be able to win another District title her final season as a Lady Dragon.

“We got off to a slow start and honestly worried me a bit,” said Keltner. “I knew once that once our bats picked up we were good, we rode off each other’s backs and hit one after another.”

Caulk also singled in the bottom of the fifth inning, Thompson and Beard scored.

Freshman Hudgins led the team in RBI’s. A grand slam was added to her resume after she blasted the ball in the bottom of the fourth inning and hit a solo home run in the bottom of the fifth inning.

McCubbins doubled and scored Milby and Catie Church to seal the shut out win and 18th District Championship title for the Lady Dragons.

A number of Lady Dragons were recognized for their performance during the

season and District Tournament play. Judd, Hudgins and Keltner were named to the 18th District All-Tournament team. Hudgins, Judd and Keltner were also named to the Fifth Region All-Season team.

Lady Dragons opened up Fifth Region play May 27 in Central Hardin against Marion County. The winner will advance to the quarter-finals May 28 against the winner of the Washington County/Elizabethtown game.
