

Board presents state rings

The Green County Board of Education met in regular session Thursday, July 11 at the central office.

Four community members were presented with state rings for their previous accomplishments: Randy Milby, 1971-1972, two-mile in track and field; Ailene Caldwell Foster, 1973, high jump; Mike Deaton, 1976, 180 yard hurdles; Larry Boyd, 1967, two mile.

In regular and special approvals:

- the approval of property, fleet and liability insurance was approved with Calhoun and Cooke Insurance, Liberty Mutual in the amount of \$128,739.
- Staff maternity leaves approved.
- First reading of the Special Education Policy and Procedure Manual approved
- The board accepted a bid to replace five leased copiers within the district. The renegotiated purchase agreement will result in an estimated \$140,000 in savings to the district over the anticipated 8-year life of the machines.
