

Ebenezer attends Presbyterian Youth Triennium

Last week Ebenezer Presbyterian Church, lead by pastor Brad Palmer, sponsored six of the church's youth and two adults to join the more than 5,000 teens and adults in the Presbyterian Youth Triennium, held every three years, on the campus of Purdue University in West Lafayette, Ind.

Tammy Pickett, Julie Smyrichinsky, and teens Ashton Bishop, Ella Cate Bishop, Taylor Bishop, Anna Coffey, Emma Howell and Layke Pickett attended the five-day event.

From July 16-20, participants attended worship services, small group meetings, group activities and special exhibits were featured.

The conference was conducted by the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and the Cumberland Presbyterian Church denominations. The event welcomed people from all across the United States and from around the world, which ran parallel with the theme "Here's my Heart."

Throughout the week, participants met, interacted, and learned from others. The group was on campus as the 50th anniversary of the Apollo 11 moon landing rolled around. They visited the Neil Armstrong building and statue as Armstrong was a Purdue graduate.

High school sophomore Layke Pickett enjoyed the week and learned a lot.

"One of the key take-aways from this experience was to be able to express and learn about diversity," Pickett said. "Wherever you go, people are basically the same. Just because you have a different skin color or different accent, does not mean that you aren't basically the same."

Julie Smyrichinsky, adult leader, shared as well.

"What we discovered was, in the end, there are more similarities than differences in all of us," said Smyrichinsky. "When we begin to focus on those similarities, rather than the differences of geography, social class, ethnicity, or background, we can
