## Post 15 safety check points

Kentucky State Police, Post 15 will be conducting safety traffic checkpoints in the Post 15 area, which includes Washington, Marion, Taylor, Green, Casey, Russell, Adair, Metcalfe, Monroe, Clinton and

Cumberland. Troopers will be checking for impaired drivers, children that are not properly restrained in child safety seats and informing the public about the use of seatbelts. These safety checkpoints will be con-

ducted in various locations throughout the Post 15 area that are experiencing a high ratio of vehicular crashes resulting in injury and/or death compared to relatively low safety restraint usage ratio.

## KSP gives monthly report

During the month of August 2019, there were 10 traffic accidents investigated by the State Police working in the Post 15 area in the 11 counties of Adair, Casey, Clinton, Cumberland, Green, Marion, Metcalfe, Monroe, Russell, Taylor and Washington.

There were three fatal collisions during the month of August in the Post 15 area.

Joseph A. Curry, 42, Metcalfe County, was killed Aug. 4 in Cumberland County.

Susan J. Harper, 41, Metcalfe County, was killed Aug. 4 in Cumberland County.

Keith D. Jewell, 44, Green County, was killed Aug. 23 in Taylor County.

This brings our yearly fatality count to 15 compared with 17 through this same period in 2018. Statewide fatality count stands at 493 compared with 473 through this same period in 2018.

During the month of August, there were 490 citations written, 115

courtesy notices written, 329 complaints answered, 37 motorists assisted, 27 criminal cases opened and 205 criminal arrests made.

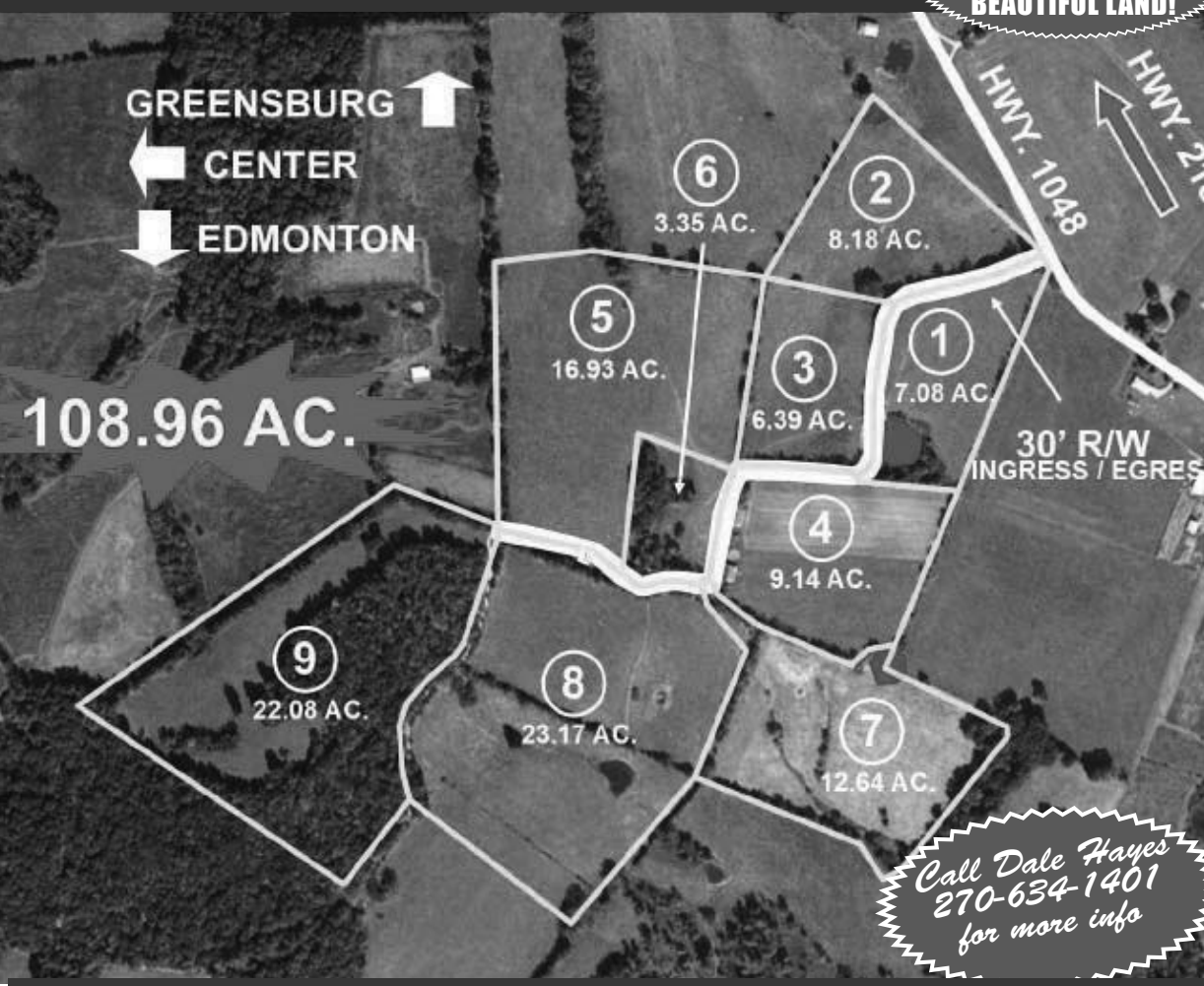
