
#### Class of 1969 Reunion

## CAIP receives over \$250K

A local County Agricultural Investment Program is among projects the Kentucky Agricultural Development Board approved funding Friday.

Green County was awarded \$285,000 for its CAIP through the Small Farm Grant Program. Statewide, \$2,127,305 was awarded in 14 agricultural diversification and rural development projects in all areas.

Green County was one of six CAIPs to re-

ceive funding. "The Green County

CAIP program is to assist farmers in making important on-farm investments," said Ricky Arnett, Green County agriculture extension agent. "It offers investment areas that give Kentucky agricultural producers the ability to increase net farm income, add value to
