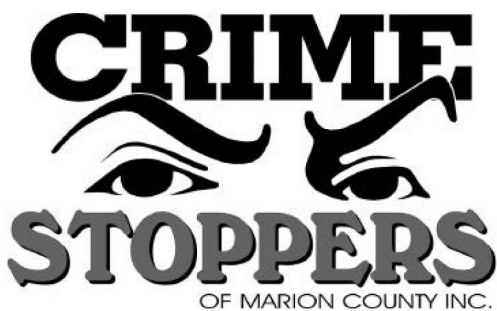

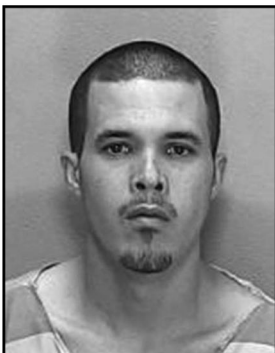

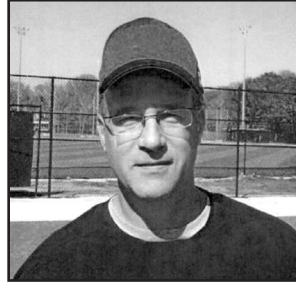
Free Baseball Clinic With Renowned Coach

Free Income Tax Preparation Assistance

United Way of Marion County will offer FREE 2018 income tax preparation at five VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) locations beginning Monday, January 14. Please call 2-1-1 to make an appointment, or for details on VITA locations available near you. You may also schedule your appointment online by visiting www.uwmc.org/VITA. All volunteers providing tax assistance are trained and certified by the Internal Revenue Service.

Residents will need to bring the following information with them:

- Government issued photo ID, such as drivers license
- Valid Social Security cards, ITN numbers, and birth dates for taxpayer, spouse, and all dependents
- All wage and income statements (example: W-2, W-2G, 1099- R forms)
- Interest and dividend statements from financial institutions (Form 1099) if applicable
- A copy of last year's federal tax return
- Proof of day care expenses including: provider's name, address and federal identification number
- For direct deposit of refund bring checking/savings account and routing numbers

If married and filing a joint return, both spouses must come to the VITA site. Those interested in volunteering as a tax preparer can contact Doug MacPhail at 352-629-0715.
