The Board, acting for and on behalf of the District, hereby declares its intention to issue General Obligation Road and Bridge Bonds of Supervisor District Four of the County in the principal amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) pursuant to the Act to raise money to provide funds for the Project. The Bonds will be general obligations of the District payable as to principal and interest out of and secured by an irrevocable pledge of the avails of a direct and continuing tax to be levied annually without limitation as to time, rate, or amount upon all the taxable property within the geographical limits of the District.

The Board proposes to direct the issuance of the Bonds of the Dis-trict in the amounts, for the purposes and secured as aforesaid at a meeting place of the Board at its meeting place in the Holmes County Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, 408 Court Square, in the City of Lexington, Mississippi, at the hour of 9:00 o'clock a.m. on February 19, 2019. SECTION 3. If on or before 9:00 o'clock

a.m. on February 19, 2019, twenty percent (20%) of the qualified electors of the District or fifteen hundred (1,500), whichever is less, shall file a written protest with the clerk of Holmes County against the issuance of the Bonds pursuant to the Act, then Bonds

The first publication of this resolution shall be made not less than twenty-one (21) days prior to the date fixed herein for the issuance of the Bonds and the last publication shall be made not more than seven (7) days prior to such date

SECTION 5. The Chancery Clerk of the Board shall be and is hereby directed to procure from the publisher of the aforesaid newspaper the customary proof of the publication of this resolution and have the same before the Board on the date and hour ified in Section 2 hereof

SECTION 6. The District reasonably expects that it will incur expenditures prior to the issuance of the Bonds, which it intends to reimburse with the proceeds of the Bonds upon the issuance thereof. This declaration of official intent to reimburse expenditures made prior to the issuance of the Bonds in anticipation of the issuance of the Bonds is made pursuant to the Reimbursement Regulations. The Project for which such expenditures are made is the same as described hereinabove. The maximum princi-pal amount of debt expected to be issued for the Project is the amount hereinabove

SECTION 7. If any one or more of the provisions of this resolution shall for any reason be held to be illegal or invalid, such illegality or invalidity shall not affect any of the other provisions of this resolution, but this resolution shall be construed and
