Goodman native trains for rural clinic practice

Jamie Riggs, a graduate of the University of Mississippi and a native of Goodman, was recently selected to participate in the pre-matriculation portion of the Mississippi Rural Physicians Scholarship Program (MRP-SP). Riggs is the daughter of Alton and Jackie Haley of Goodman.

Created in 2007, MRPSP identifies college sophomores and juniors who demonstrate the necessary commitment and academic achievement to become competent, well-trained rural primary care physicians in our state. The program offers undergraduate academic enrichment and a clinical experience in a rural setting. Upon completion of all medical school admissions requirements, the student can be admitted to the University of Mississippi School of Medicine or William Carey University College of Osteopathic Medicine.

During medical school, each MRPSP scholar may receive \$30,000 per year based on available funding.

Consistent legislative support of MRPSP translates to 61 medical students receiving a total of \$1,830,000 to support their education this fall. Additional benefits include personalized mentoring from practicing rural
