

Work continues on Norell Road Interchange at I-20

Work continues on Interstate 20 at the Norrell Road interchange in Hinds County. This project will provide needed interchange improvements for the new Continental Tire plant. The project will provide new geometry for the interchange, and realign and widen the frontage and local roads.

The bridge on I-20 eastbound has been widened on the north side, and crews are currently widening the bridge on the south side. New box culvert construction is underway, and crews are constructing a new bridge over the railroad for the frontage road, which will serve as the main entrance into the plant.

"Transportation is the driving force of a strong economy," said Commissioner Dick Hall, chair, Mississippi Transportation Commission. "This project will help boost economic growth and development not only locally, but also throughout the region."

Joe McGee Construction Company, Inc., of Lake, was awarded the approximately \$27 million construction contract. Work started in March 2018, and is scheduled to be complete in late fall 2019.

Shelter scholarship open for applications

This spring, the Shelter Insurance Foundation will award a \$2,000 scholarship to two graduates of Clinton High School. Shelter Agent Ricky Nations sponsors and partially funds these scholarships.

A committee of local high school officials and community leaders will select the local recipients. The committee will consider each applicant's scholastic achievements, educational goals, citizenship, moral character and participation and leadership in school and community activities. The scholarship is given without regard to race, disability, religion, national origin or gender of applicants. The names of the recipients will be announced at the close of the school year. The students may apply the scholarship funds toward tuition, fees, or campus housing for any course of study beginning the fall after the recipient's high school graduation and leading to an academic degree at any accredited college or university. The Foundation makes payment directly to the school the recipient selects.

Mississippi College to offer pharmacy technician training

Mississippi College's Office of Continuing Education will sponsor a Pharmacy Technician Training Program beginning March 11. The course fee is \$1,199 for a total of fifty hours. Course content includes medical terminology specific to the pharmacy, reading and interpreting prescriptions, and defining drugs by generic and brand names. Students will learn dosage calculations, I.V. flow rate, drug compounding, dose conversions, dispensing of prescriptions, inventory control, and billing and reimbursement.

Students who complete the course could be qualified to sit for National Certification Exams.
