School district shares designs for school renovations, additions

with safety in mind so that visitors must enter through the school office.

A longtime issue with the Lovett school driveway will be addressed so that car and bus traffic is segregated and the school entrance is easier to navigate for morning drop-off and afternoon dismissal. Eastside and Northside Elementary schools, which house secondfifth-graders, will through get additional classrooms as needed to replace portable classrooms permanent additions. with

Clinton Park Elementary, the district's kindergarten and first-grade facility, will see an expanded cafeteria and additional classrooms. The cafeteria expansion will allow

the school to have a shorter window to get all classes through for lunch, instead of beginning lunch at midmorning and ending in the afternoon.

Construction at the high school, along with and renovation projects at Clinton Park, Lovett, and Northside/Eastside are expected to begin this summer. Expansion of the CHS band hall is also expected to begin this summer.

Late 2019 and early 2020 are expected to see the opening of the new CHS Career Complex classrooms and labs at the CHS main campus, along with the start of renovations to the former CHS Career Complex facility that will become a part of the CJHS campus. In the summer of 2020, the district expects to renovate the old fine arts

area at CJHS into administrative offices and convert old administrative

offices at CJHS into classrooms, with all work completed by fall of 2020.
