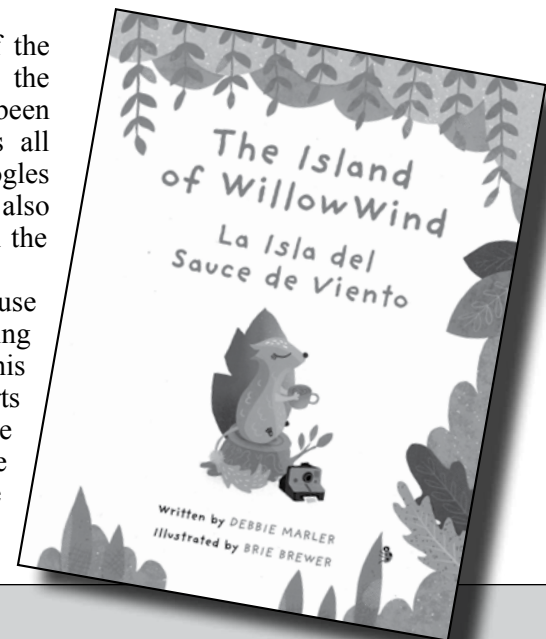

Total of \$232,500 raised so far for Lions Club Park

"We heard rumors that MC might sell the land," Barnett said. Main Street Clinton Director Tara Lytal asked Barnett to meet with then-MC President Dr. Lee Royce to ask what MC's plans were for the park land.

During the meeting with Dr. Royce, Barnett learned that "half of the trustees wanted to sell, and the other half didn't." However, Dr. Royce assured Barnett that, regardless of what the board of trustees decided to do with the property, the university would ensure there would be a Lions Club Park.

Mississippi College sold the 2.7 acre site of the Lions Club Park to Chartre Corp., a developer in Oxford, Mississippi. In December 2017, at a Board of Aldermen meeting, Chartre unveiled plans for Hillman Commons, a 95-unit apartment complex and retail space to be constructed at the site.

Chartre pledged financial support for the new Lions Club Park, and MC provided a parcel of land on Leake Street that adjoins the First Baptist Church parking lot and is adjacent to the new replica Train Depot in Olde Towne Clinton.

An individual, Mississippi College and Chartre all donated funds for the project, and the Lions Club requested a \$100,000 grant from Lions International for the project, citing in the grant application that more than 10,000 households and the Challenger

League Programs will utilize the new park.

The Lions Club received the \$100,000 for the new Hillman-Berry Lions Club Park, which, combined with the other donations, currently bring total funds raised for the park to \$232,500.

Barnett, a member of the Clinton Lions Club, predicts the new park will be better than ever.

"Everything will be ADA-compliant, and we'll have a pavilion on the west end, as well. Being so close to the Train Depot, visitors will be able to take advantage of the restroom facilities there. We don't intend to remove any trees unless they're diseased, so it's going to be a great green space in the heart of Olde Towne with wonderful playground equipment."

Final design and layout of the park will be determined after site investigations and subsequent engineering and design processes. All existing pieces of play equipment will be reconditioned and relocated, with the exception of the oversized metal caterpillar.

"Though it will no longer be used as play equipment, it will be proudly positioned to serve as the centerpiece of the new and improved park," Barnett said. "It's going to be a giant step forward, for sure, but it wouldn't be Lions Club Park without that caterpillar."
