

# Proctor help needed for CPSD state tests

The Clinton Public School District needs community volunteers to help proctor state testing this spring.

Proctors and hall monitors ensure the integrity of state testing. They assist teachers with testing duties, including passing out test materials, monitoring students, collecting materials when everyone is finished and monitoring the halls to help the school follow test security protocol.

Proctors must be eighteen years of age or older and will need to be able to be on their feet for an hour or two each day. All proctors and hall monitors have to be trained by school personnel at the building where they are volunteering. Training times will be determined when proctors sign up to volunteer.
