CPSD holds groundbreaking for new facilities

Late last month, the Clinton Public School District broke ground on

the new Clinton High School Career Complex facilities at the main Clinton High School campus. Current facilities on the Lakeview Drive campus of

Clinton Junior High School will be relocated to Arrow Drive. The project is being made possible through the \$25 million 2018 bond issue that passed

with ninety-five percent approval.

Through the summer of 2019, expansions are slated to begin on Clin-

Street and roadway work begins around city

Street and roadway improvements have begun throughout the City of Clinton and will continue throughout the summer. With \$3 million budgeted for roadway projects, City officials say several heavily traveled roadways will see vast improvements to their roadbed.

The Clinton Parkway will be milled and overlaid with new asphalt, and areas that require it will have subgrade removed and new structure constructed. Crosswalks will be reworked as needed in the area of College and Fairmont

Streets. The total cost for the project to replace the roadbed and improve the crosswalks is \$1.145 million. Construction is expected to begin in mid-June.

Portions of four streets have also been slated for significant reconstruction. They include Briarwood Drive, Woodridge Place, Easthaven Drive and Welbourne Circle (roundabout). Repairs will require removal of asphalt and the subsurface, then replacement of new material to provide for smoother streets. The improvements will also allow for replacement of substandard materials, including curbs and gutters, where required, to provide for an improved

ride and also to assist in drainage in the areas of these improvements.

Repair work on Briarwood Drive began last last month and is expected to continue through June 20. Repairs to Woodbridge will begin around June 24 and be completed on approximately July 18. Repairs to Bruenburg Parkway (Welbourne Circle) will begin on July 22 and run through August 20. Reconstruction of the northern end of Easthaven Drive will begin August 21, with a completion date of September 11. Completion dates are dependent upon weather.
