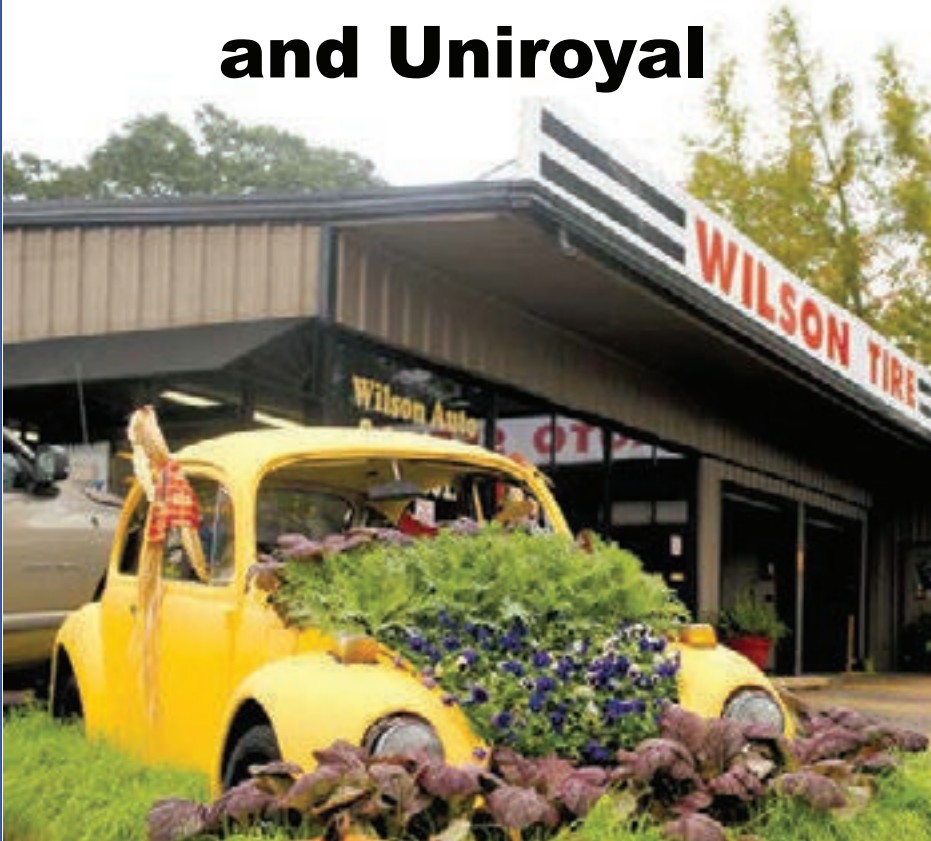

The Clinton Quisenberry Library Summer Reading Program (SRP) is in full swing, but readers who want to register to take part in Summer Reading may still do so.

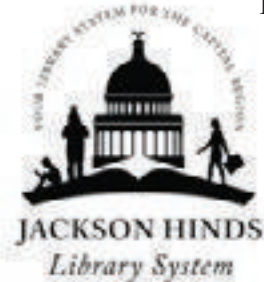
Organizers say participating in SRP keeps reading skills sharp during school's summer break and helps keep adults focused on the importance of reading for themselves and their families.

BE MOSQUITO FREE! PREVENTION & PROTECTION

DRAIN

Remove standing water from around your home. It only takes a bottle cap's worth of standing water to cause a mosquito problem.

Common culprits that should be monitored regularly for standing water include:

- clogged rain gutters,
- corrugated drain pipes,
- bird baths,
- pet bowls,
- trash & recycling bins,
- plant pots, and
- children's toys.

DRESS

When practical, wear long pants and long sleeves. Loose-fitting, light-colored clothing is best.

Studies have shown that some mosquitoes are more attracted to dark clothing and can most readily bite through tight-fitting, loose-weave clothing.

DEFEND

Use repellent! The EPA has registered repellents that have been reviewed and approved to pose minimal risk when used properly:

- DEET (N, N-diethyl-m-toluamide)
- Picaridin (KBR 3023)
- Oil of lemon eucalyptus (p-methan 3,4-diol, or PMD)
