The Clinton Public School District has announced dates for students to pick up or swap their Apple devices for the upcoming school year. Parents must attend with their children in order for the device to be swapped out or picked up, as applicable.

Grade 6

Returning students in grade 6 will receive their iPad and padded backpack on Saturday, August 10, at Clinton High School. Students will attend an "Introduction to Your iPad" orientation session, and times will be given out at Lovett's registration day. A parent or guardian must be present with their

child during the August 10 orientation.

Students entering sixth grade who are NEW to CPSD will receive their iPad and backpack at 4:30 p.m. Thursday, August 15, at Lovett. This orientation session will be held prior to Lovett's Back to School night at 6 p.m. A parent or guardian must be with their child.

Grades 7-8

Students who are NEW to CPSD entering grades 7-8 will receive their iPad and backpack during an Introduction to Your iPad session at 4:30 p.m. Wednesday, August 14, at Clinton High School. A parent or guardian must be with their child.

Grades 9

Returning students in grade 9 will swap out their iPad and iPad charger for a Macbook and Macbook charger on August 6 during on-site registration at Summer Hill. Students must bring their iPad, their iPad charger, and their backpack to registration in order to bring their Macbook home.

Students who are NEW to CPSD and entering grade 9 will receive their MacBook and backpack during a Meet Your Mac session at 6 p.m. Wednesday, August 14, at Clinton High School. A parent or guardian must be with their child.
