Organizers continue prepping for Red Brick Roads Music and Arts Festival

Marc Broussard will be headlining on Saturday evening, and singer songwriter Yoke Lore will be the headliner on Friday evening. Other acts include Repeat Repeat, Shelly Fairchild, J & the Causeways, Empty Atlas, Sam Mooney, Chance Peña, Ally and Ryan Warnick.

The festival starts on Friday night, August 23, with a songwriter round robin featuring a local artist showcase at 7 p.m. Headliner Yoke Lore will end the evening at 8:45 p.m. Gates open at 6 p.m. on Friday.

Patrons may choose to head back to the brick streets on Saturday, August 24, and shop the Red Brick Roads Craft Festival. The Red Brick Roads Talent Competition will begin at 1 p.m., and the Red Brick Brew Homebrew Competition will be at 3:30 p.m. Musical



acts will begin at 4 p.m., closing with headliner Mark Broussard. Gates open at noon on Saturday.

Downtown businesses will be encouraged to keep their doors open for late-day, early evening shoppers. Attendees can also shop from Red Brick Roads vendors, who will have booths on Monroe Street on Saturday. Attendees may bring lawn chairs and friends, but no coolers, and enjoy a weekend on the brick streets.

A weekend pass to the event is \$20, a Friday-only pass is \$10, and a Saturday-only pass is \$15. VIP tickets, which include access to an exclusive VIP area with complimentary drinks and small bites, private air-conditioned restrooms, and an exclusive viewing area, are available for \$125. Children under 10 will be admitted free.


