The VFW Post 4238 in Dixon was recognized as one of the top posts in the world in 2018.

The ladies also assist the men of Post #4238 in placing hundreds of American Flags on Veterans' graves for Memorial Day in the Dixon area.

The Dixon American Legion Post 298 was named after two WWI veterans, Jacob Liesmann and Tom Roberts, and was chartered on March 20, 1920 with 19 members. The Legion traditions of service to veterans and to the youth of the area have been strong throughout their history. A Post meeting is held the second Thursday of each month. The Post aids many charitable, civic and other organizations each year. The Post provides a Color Guard for parades, Memorial Day and veterans day activities. Also the Post has an Honor Guard that



provides a Military funeral service for veterans. They also participate in activities at the St. James Veterans Home such as Bingo, and the annual Christmas store.

In addition the Post sponsors youth programs such as Boys State, Oratorical Competition, Boy Scouts, School awards, Cadet Patrol, and 2016 marked the ninth straight year that Post 298 has sponsored an American Legion AA Baseball Team and a Legion A Baseball Team.
