History of the Hancock Christian Church

The Hancock Christian Church was organized at the Brown Schoolhouse, which was a log building, on October 21, 1871 with 34 charter members. Jacob Teeple and James N. Routh were chosen as elders, John Roberts and Hoard Claybrook were chosen deacons. In 1880 a schoolhouse was built in Hancock. Soon after that the congregation moved to the new schoolhouse.

In 1905 a new school building was built where this building stands. The old building was sold to Mr. and Mrs. Harve Goodman, who gave the

building and some land to the church. The building was then moved to where it stood until it was torn down in 1988.

In 1986 it was decided to build a new church building. All different kinds of gifts began coming in. A ground breaking was held October 12, 1986. The congregation moved into the new building December 12, 1987.

Through the years many descendants of the charter members have become members of this congregation
