  - ◆ Pre-registered exhibitors may still add or remove items from their registration form when they bring their items to the fair.

- ◆ Entries will be accepted after August 9, but it is requested that after August 9, you email your entries or bring your entry form with you to the fair on August 21.

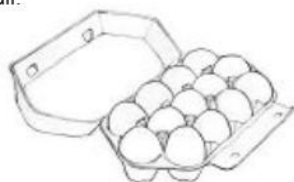
**DEPARTMENT 107 — POULTRY**

- ◆ *Tentatively scheduled Poultry will be judged at 11:00 a.m. Thursday.*
- ◆ Premiums for eggs:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$1.75; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$1.50; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$1.25; 4<sup>th</sup> place: \$1.00
- ◆ Premiums for poultry:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$2.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$1.75; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$1.50; 4<sup>th</sup> place: \$1.25

**CLASS A — EGGS**

Eggs shall be brought on *Wednesday* to the main exhibit hall.

- ◆ *Rabbits will be judged after poultry on Thursday. Exhibitor shall show animal.*

- 108.....G..... 4 ..... Doe with young



**DEPARTMENT 111 — EXOTICS**

- ◆ *Exotics will be judged Thursday after poultry and rabbits. Animals shown shall be free of disease, and show proof of up to date vaccinations.*
- ◆ Premiums for Department 11:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$5.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$4.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$3.00; 4<sup>th</sup> place: \$2.00

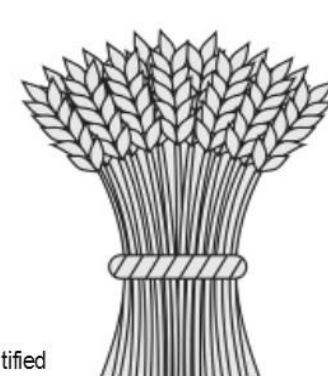


**DEPARTMENT 114 — FRUITS AND VEGETABLES**

- ◆ Must be free of insects and disease
- ◆ For preparing exhibits refer to Publication A3306 Exhibiting and Judging Vegetables, and it can be found online at <http://learningstore.uwex.edu/assets/pdfs/a3306.pdf>
- ◆ Premiums for field crops & potatoes:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$2.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$1.75; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$1.50; 4<sup>th</sup> place: \$1.25
- ◆ Premiums for Garden Crops (other than potatoes), herbs & fruit (other than apples):
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$1.75; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$1.50; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$1.25; 4<sup>th</sup> place: \$1.00
- ◆ Premiums for Apples:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$2.50; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$2.25; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$2.00; 4<sup>th</sup> place: \$1.50
- ◆ Premiums for vegetable garden display of 6 different vegetables or 5 varieties of apples:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$5.50; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$4.50; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$3.50; 4<sup>th</sup> place: \$2.50

**CLASS A — FIELD CROPS**

- ◆ All crops must be the result of the current crop season
- ◆ Grain Sheaves must have leaves stripped and tied (minimum of 2 ties)
- ◆ Stalks of corn must have roots removed
- ◆ Sunflowers must have roots removed
- 114.....A..... 1 ..... Hybrid corn (5 ears < 85d)
- 114.....A..... 2 ..... Hybrid corn (5 ears > 85d)
- 114.....A..... 3 ..... Winter wheat (4 qts.)
- 114.....A..... 4 ..... Spring wheat (4 qts.)
- 114.....A..... 5 ..... Winter rye (4 qts.)
- 114.....A..... 6 ..... Oats (4 qts.)
- 114.....A..... 7 ..... Barley (4 qts.)
- 114.....A..... 8 ..... Sugar (feed) beets (4 qts.)
- 114.....A..... 9 ..... Field Peas (4 qts.)

**CLASS B — GARDEN CROPS**

- ◆ Cabbages are to have outer leaves left on, but trimmed
- ◆ For any other variety categories, variety must be identified
- ◆ No vegetables that are hazardous to human consumption allowed
- ◆ Onions are to be cleaned, but not peeled back
- ◆ Potatoes are to be cleaned but not washed

- 114.....B..... 2 ..... Beans, yellow (15)
- 114.....B..... 3 ..... Beans, purple (15)
- 114.....B..... 4 ..... Beets (6)
