

**YOUTH CLASS—Traditional Exhibits**

- ◆ All Florence County youth, may enter exhibits in the fair. Youth class is defined as:
  - ◆ Children under the age of 5, can only enter exhibits listed in Department 17a below.
  - ◆ Children ages 5-6 may only enter exhibits listed in Department 17 Classes B through H below.
  - ◆ Any child having completed first grade, through grade 12, may enter the rest of the exhibits listed as Youth Class: Departments 1-16 and 18-34.
- ◆ Registration is FREE.
  - ◆ Pre-Registration is until August 9.
  - ◆ Those pre-registered will have their entry tags printed and waiting for them when they come to drop off their exhibits.
  - ◆ Pre-registered exhibitors may still add or remove items from their registration form when they bring their items to the fair.
  - ◆ Anyone pre-registered for their fair exhibits will receive a coupon for a free treat from Lydia's fair kitchen.
- ◆ Entries will be accepted after August 9, but it is requested that after August 9, you email your entries or bring your entry form with you to the fair on August 21. All items must be registered by August 21.

- 3.) Judging will be done with Danish placing, and ribbons will be awarded.
- 4.) All work should be done by the child.
- 5.) All drawings should be done on regular size paper 8 1/2" x 11"
- 6.) Only one entry per lot (one of each type of entry) can be submitted.
- 7.) No premiums will be paid out. Exhibitors will receive a coupon for a treat from Lydia's Fair Kitchen

- ◆ FOR 2019 — All poultry are EXEMPT from the requirement of having a pullarium test.
- ◆ Premiums for eggs:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$1.75; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$1.50; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$1.25; 4<sup>th</sup> place: \$1.00
- ◆ Premiums for poultry:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$2.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$1.75; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$1.50; 4<sup>th</sup> place: \$1.25
