- ◆ Larger wearing apparel should be on hangers
- ◆ Posters should be size appropriate for display with maximum size of 14"x22"
- ◆ Smaller items may be placed in plastic bags
- ◆ Tied Fleece Blankets & Pillows that are tied and not sewn are to be entered in Department 28 and not in Department 26
