- ◆ Display trays will be available at exhibit registration
- ◆ For any other variety categories, variety must be identified

- ◆ Must be free of insects and disease
- ◆ No vegetables that are hazardous to human consumption allowed
- ◆ Onions are to be cleaned, but not peeled back
- ◆ Potatoes are to be cleaned but not washed

Box must have 6 of the following: tomatoes, 3; sweet corn, 3 ears husked; onions, 4; peppers, 3; beets, 4 roots; lettuce, head or leaf, 1; squash, 1; or cucumbers, pickling, 4 or slicing, 3.
